Cash transactions were not available, checking accounts were not even offered and approved loans were distributed, once a week, after review by the Credit Committee.

Yes, times have definitely altered our products, operations and even the name of our credit union, but due to the integrity and service consistently contributed by Bob, TVFCU exemplifies the strength and reputation that he has helped us achieve. Throughout his 25 year tenure, Bob’s sound judgment and analytical assessment were always recognized as prudent financial advice.
